Practicing reading Nonfiction:

I can...

- Compare fiction to nonfiction
- Tell how text features are used to help the reader understand the text better
- Explain photographs and captions and how they help me understand the text better

- In math we are...
 Sorting 2-D and 3-D shapes by common attributes
- Sort and name polygons by number of sides
- Identify quadrilaterals by 4 sides and 4 angles
- Explain rectangles as 4-sided shapes with 4 right angles
- Arrange square tiles in rows and columns to make rectangles
- Describe a rectangular array by number of rows, number of tiles in each row and total
