Practicing reading Nonfiction:

I can...

- Tell how text features are used to help the reader understand the text better
- Explain how special type (bold words, etc.), headings/subheadings, table of contents and a glossary help me understand the text better

In math we are...

- Describing a rectangular array using square tiles with rows, number of tiles in each row and total tiles
- Making rectangles on a geoboard
- Identifying attributes of a rectangle
- Partitioning and identifying one half a rectangle, a triangle, a hexagon and a circle
- Understanding equal parts of a whole
- Recognizing that halves of the same shape can look different

- Plan my writing to write all I know with a table of contents
- > Include:

 - o page numbers
 - introduction

In social studies we are... Exploring a map of our local community with a title, map key, important natural and human characteristics and transportation.
