Practicing reading Realistic Fiction:

I can...

- Tell the important things in a story in order from the beginning, middle and end
- Explain how the character is feeling and how it is shown by the writer and illustrator
- Make predictions about the characters based on their dialogue and behaviors

In math we are...

- Using a place value model to represent a 2-digit number as tens and ones
- Showing tens/ones using equation such as 22 = 20 + 2 or 22 = 10 + 10 + 2
- Determining the difference between a 2-digit number and a multiple of 10 up to 100
- Finding combinations of 2-digit numbers such as 3 tens and 6 ones or 2 tens and 16 ones for 36

- > Create individual writing goals
- > Use my ideas to plan my stories
- > Storytell to elaborate my stories
- Include actions, thoughts and feelings
