- Know that the characters' actions in the story lead to the solution

## In math we are...

- Describe and interpret what the data shows about the group surveyed
- Compare representations of the same set of data
- Represent data on a picture graph
- Make a plan for collecting data
- Ordering, representing and describing a set of numerical data

## This week we are writing Narrative:

- Plan my story:
  - Beginning: hook the reader
  - Middle: setting, characters, thoughts, feelings, actions
  - Ending: wrap up
