I can...

- Explain the beginning of a story that introduces the characters and setting.
- Identify the characters and their traits (What is the character like? How do they act?)
- Tell the important events in order.
- Describe how a character responds to the major events in a story.
- Tell how the character will react.

In math we are...

- Sorting the same set of data in different ways based on similar attributes
- Representing a set of data sorted up to 4 categories in bar graphs, etc.
- Describe and interpret what the data shows about the group surveyed
- Compare representations of the same set of data
- Represent data on a line plot and picture graph

This week we are writing

Research Reports:

- Plan a research report with a table of contents, sections, text features
- Elaborate the facts on each page or section with details
- End the report with a conclusion
- Revise using the rubric
